

MoveOn at the University of Manitoba (UM)

Background: Why MoveOn?

The University of Manitoba encourages and supports the international mobility of students, faculty and staff through a variety of partnerships, programs and initiatives. Historically, UM units with direct association with or responsibility for these partnerships kept and maintained records of their respective programs. As international engagement increases, UM saw the need to track and gather consistent data across diverse programs and units, to both facilitate program management and to provide information for decision making and risk management interventions by UM administration. MoveOn was purchased by UM to fill this gap.

Specifically, MoveOn database serves as a tool for:

- Institutional partnership management
- Track & facilitate visiting delegations
- Data collection & analysis of institutional international activities
- Track & manage student mobility
- Travel risk management

MoveOn Implementation Groups

The International Office (IO), under the VP Research and International, is the lead unit implementing the adoption of MoveOn database across UM with the support of a Technical Team.
